

## Is there a case for treating malnutrition in older people in Europe?

#### Prevalence

- Malnourished
- 5-20% in home care
- 15-35% in hospitals
- 10-75% in nursing homes
- At risk
- 32% in community
- 47% in hospital

#### Consequences

- Health care cost: 170b in Europe
- Healthy & active
- Risks & adverse clinical Outcomes (frailty/sarcopenia/infe ctions/wound healing)
- Stay at hospital
- Long term care

#### Intervention

- •Awareness & education (general population, professionals, care-givers, managers, policy)
- •Screening, assessment, treatment, monitoring
- •Concerted, coordinated management & policy action.



#### Muscle loss: a major modifiable cause of frailty in the elderly.






