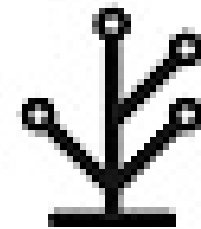

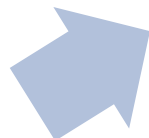

SLAS Europe was established to engage scientists working in the fields of laboratory automation, technology and screening with education and networking opportunities in Europe.

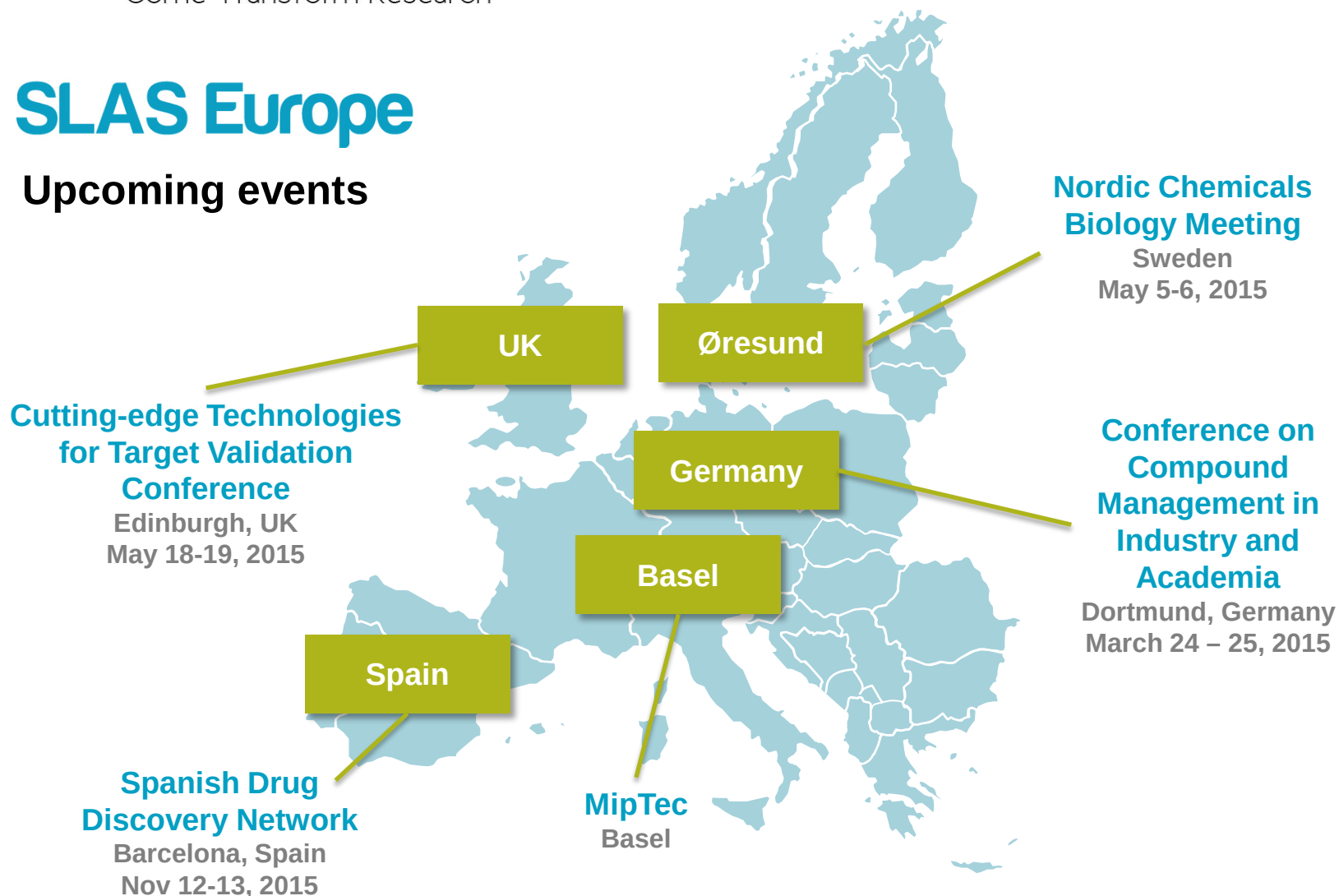
To achieve our vision SLAS Europe has adopted a strategy of working in partnership with sister organizations within five regions across Europe:
